- 2 relating to pharmacies that maintain emergency medication kits at
- 3 certain institutions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 562.108(a), Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A Class A or Class C pharmacy, or a Class E pharmacy
- 8 located not more than 20 miles from an institution in this state
- 9 that is licensed under Chapter 242 or 252, Health and Safety Code,
- 10 may maintain controlled substances and dangerous drugs in an
- 11 emergency medication kit used at an institution licensed under
- 12 those chapters [Chapter 242 or 252, Health and Safety Code]. The
- 13 controlled substances and dangerous drugs may be used only for the
- 14 emergency medication needs of a resident at that institution. A
- 15 Class E pharmacy may not maintain drugs in an emergency medication
- 16 kit for an institution that is located more than 20 miles from the
- 17 pharmacy.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
