1-7 Amend H.B. No. 1691 as follows:

1-8 (1) In SECTION 1 of the bill, in proposed Subsection (c-1),  
1-9 Section 42.152, Education Code, (Committee Printing, page 1, line  
1-10 22), between "fund" and ":", insert "in proportion to the  
1-11 percentage of students served by the program that meet the criteria  
1-12 in Section 29.081 (d) or (g)".

1-13 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-14 AN ACT

1-15 relating to use of the compensatory education allotment to fund  
1-16 certain programs for students who have dyslexia or a related  
1-17 disorder.

1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-19 SECTION 1. Section 42.152, Education Code, is amended by  
1-20 adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:

1-21 (c-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (c), funds allocated under  
1-22 this section may be used to fund:

1-23 (1) an accelerated reading instruction program under  
1-24 Section 28.006(g); or

1-25 (2) a program for treatment of students who have  
1-26 dyslexia or a related disorder as required by Section 38.003.

1-27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
