- Sec. 107.002. TRAINING IN GERONTOLOGY; RULES; NOTICE. (a)
- 16 Each state regulatory agency that licenses health care
- 17 practitioners shall adopt rules to approve training in gerontology
- 18 as acceptable for continuing education, particularly for
- 19 practitioners who, in the normal course of their professional
- 20 practice, provide health care services to elderly persons.
- 21 (b) A state regulatory agency affected by this section
- 22 shall:
- 23 (1) adopt rules regarding the eligibility of
