## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to deductions from the salaries of school district

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 22.001, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (a-1), (d), and (e)
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a-1) A school district may adopt one or more forms to be
- 9 used to file a request under Subsection (a)(1) or to provide
- 10 information under Subsection (a)(2).
- 11 (b) The district shall deduct the total amount of the fees
- or dues for a year in equal amounts per pay period for the number of
- 13 periods specified by the employee. Except as provided by
- 14 <u>Subsection (e), the [The]</u> deductions shall be made until the
- employee requests in writing that the deductions be discontinued.
- 16 (d) A school district may not impose conditions or
- 17 requirements, other than those authorized or required by this
- 18 section or other law, in connection with making a deduction from a
- 19 <u>district employee's salary for membership fees or dues to a</u>
- 20 professional organization.
- (e) Not later than December 1 of each year, each
- 22 professional organization that has one or more members who have an
- 23 amount deducted from the member's school district salary for
- 24 membership fees or dues to the organization shall provide each of

those members a notice that states the total amount of fees and dues 1 2 to the organization to be deducted from the employee's salary for that year. The notice also must inform the employee of the manner 3 4 in which the deductions may be discontinued and provide a form for that purpose. A district may not at any time make any further 5 6 deductions from a district employee's salary for membership fees or 7 dues to a professional organization that has failed to make a good faith effort to comply with this subsection. A district shall make 8 a determination of whether a professional organization has failed 9 to make a good faith effort to comply with this subsection in 10 accordance with a policy adopted by the board of trustees of the 11 district. 12

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
