13	the contractor is in compliance with contract documents material to
14	the condition or defect that was the proximate cause of the personal
15	injury, property damage, or death.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and applies only to a cause of action that accrues on or after that date. An action that accrued before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law applicable to the action immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
