4	SECTION 1. Title 4 of the Civil Practice & Remedies Code is
5	hereby amended by adding Chapter 95A to read as follows:
6	CHAPTER 95A. LIABILITY OF CONTRACTORS OF
7	HIGHWAYS, ROADS OR STREETS
8	Sec. 95A.001. LIMIT ON LIABILITY. (a) A contractor who
9	performs the construction or repair of any highway, road or street
10	for any governmental unit is not liable for personal injury,
11	property damage, or death to third parties resulting from or
12	arising out of the performance of or any failure to perform the
13	construction or repair if, at the time of such personal injury,
14	property damage or death, the contractor is in substantial
15	compliance with all specifications for such construction or repair
16	required by the contracting governmental unit.
17	(b) A contractor who performs the construction or repair of
18	any highway, road or street for any governmental unit may be liable
19	for personal injury, property damage, or death to third parties
20	resulting from or arising out of the performance of or any failure
21	to perform the construction or repair if, at the time of such
22	personal injury, property damage or death, the contractor is not in
23	substantial compliance with all specifications for such
24	construction or repair required by the contracting governmental

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## unit and such failure is the proximate cause of the personal injury, property damage or death to a third party.

3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and 4 applies to a cause of action that accrues on or after that date. An 5 action that accrued before the effective date of this Act is 6 governed by the law in effect at the time the action accrued, and

7 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
