(b) An insurer may not refuse to issue a policy described by
Subsection (a) based on a single water damage claim by the applicant
if the claim does not arise out of the negligence of the applicant.

SECTION 3. This Act applies only to the issuance of an insurance policy on or after the effective date of this Act or the renewal or nonrenewal of an insurance policy on or after the 45th day after the effective date of this Act. The issuance of an insurance policy before the effective date of this Act or the renewal or nonrenewal of an insurance policy before the 45th day after the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
