- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 441, Health and Safety Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 441. REGULATION OF BOTTLED AND VENDED DRINKING WATER
- 8 OPERATORS
- 9 Sec. 441.001. DEFINITIONS [DEFINITION]. In this chapter:
- 10 (1) "Commissioner" means the commissioner of public
- 11 health.

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- 12 (2) "Department" [, "department"] means the Texas
- 13 Department of Health.
- 14 Sec. 441.002. PROHIBITED ACTS [CERTIFICATION OF BOTTLED AND
- 15 <u>VENDED WATER OPERATORS</u>]. (a) A bottled or vended water operator
- 16 may not furnish bottled or vended water to the public or for
- 17 distribution to the public unless the bottled or vended water
- 18 operator holds a <u>permit</u> [certificate of competency] under this
- 19 chapter.
- 20 (b) A person may not furnish bottled or vended water to the
- 21 public or for distribution to the public unless the processing,
- 22 bottling, and distribution of the bottled or vended water are
- 23 performed by or under the supervision of a bottled or vended water
- 24 operator who holds a permit [certificate of competency] under this

- 1 chapter.
- Sec. 441.003. PERMIT. (a) A bottled or vended water
- 3 operator may apply to the department for a permit to furnish or
- 4 distribute bottled or vended water to the public.
- 5 (b) The department by rule shall provide the procedures for
- 6 the issuance of a permit under this chapter. A permit may be issued
- 7 only for the purpose and use stated on the application for the
- 8 permit.
- 9 (c) A permit may not be issued to a bottled or vended water
- 10 operator who does not comply with the standards prescribed by the
- 11 department under this chapter.
- 12 (d) A permit issued under this chapter must be renewed each
- 13 year in accordance with department rules.
- Sec. 441.004. FEES. (a) $\left[\frac{b}{b}\right]$ To obtain or renew a
- 15 <u>permit</u>, [certificate] an applicant must pay the department a [\$25]
- 16 fee set by rule by the department in an amount reasonable and
- 17 necessary to administer this chapter.
- 18 (b) (c) On receipt of the required fee, the department
- 19 shall provide for the testing of the applicant and issue a permit
- 20 [certificate of competency] to the applicant if the applicant
- 21 passes the test and complies with department standards.
- 22 Sec. 441.005. [441.003.] RULES; MINIMUM STANDARDS. (a)
- 23 The department may adopt rules [that are] necessary to implement
- 24 this chapter that promote the public health and safety, including
- 25 rules related[. The rules may include rules relating] to:
- 26 <u>(1) permit</u> [certificate] suspension, permit
- 27 revocation, or other disciplinary action; and

- 1 (2) permit [relating to certificate] renewal.
- 2 (b) The department by rule shall establish reasonable
- 3 minimum standards for granting or maintaining a permit.
- 4 Sec. 441.006. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER LAW. Chapter 431
- 5 applies to a person or product regulated under this chapter,
- 6 including a bottled or vended water operator who holds a permit
- 7 <u>under this chapter.</u>
- 8 Sec. 441.007. REFUSAL TO GRANT PERMIT; SUSPENSION OR
- 9 REVOCATION OF PERMIT. In accordance with rules and minimum
- 10 standards adopted under Section 441.005, the commissioner may
- 11 refuse an application for a permit under this chapter or may suspend
- or revoke a permit issued under this chapter.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 431, Health and Safety
- 14 Code, is amended by adding Section 431.011 to read as follows:
- Sec. 431.011. APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER TO BOTTLED OR VENDED
- 16 WATER OPERATORS. This chapter applies to the conduct of a person
- who holds a permit under Chapter 441.
- 18 SECTION 3. (a) The Texas Department of Health shall adopt
- 19 the rules, procedures, and minimum standards required by Chapter
- 20 441, Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act, not later than
- 21 December 1, 2003.
- 22 (b) The Texas Department of Health shall treat a person who
- 23 holds a certificate of competency under Chapter 441, Health and
- 24 Safety Code, immediately before the effective date of this Act, as
- 25 if the person holds a permit under Chapter 441, Health and Safety
- 26 Code, as amended by this Act. On expiration of the certificate of
- 27 competency, the department shall issue a permit to a person who

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- 1 holds a certificate and who would be eligible to renew a permit.
- 2 Each person who holds a certificate of competency must obtain a
- 3 permit not later than September 1, 2004.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
