- 10 has entered a court appearance or signed court pleadings in a matter

- 12 (b) A local public official that has a substantial interest
- in a business entity as described by Subsection (a) must comply with
- 14 this chapter.
- 15 (c) A judge of a statutory county court may not enter a court
- 16 appearance or sign court pleadings as an attorney in any matter

- 18 <u>(1) the court over which the judge presides; or</u>
- 19 <u>(2) any court in this state over which the judge's</u>
- 20 <u>court exercises appellate jurisdiction.</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 171.010(c), Local Government Code, as
- 22 added by this Act, applies only to the entrance of an appearance or
- 23 pleading signed on or after September 1, 2003.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
