- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Subsection 706.002(a), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) A political subdivision may contract with the
 7 department to provide information necessary for the department to
 8 deny renewal of the driver's license of a person who fails to appear
 9 for a complaint or citation or fails to pay or satisfy a judgment
 10 ordering payment of a fine and cost in the manner ordered by the
 11 court in a matter involving any offense that a [justice or
 12 municipal] court has jurisdiction of under Chapter 4, [Article 4.11]
- 12 municipal court has jurisdiction of under chapter 4, [Article 4.1
- 13 $\frac{\text{or } 4.14_{7}}{\text{or }}$] Code of Criminal Procedure.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act will take effect immediately if it
- 15 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 16 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 17 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 18 effect, this Act takes effect on September 1, 2003.
