5 SECTION 1. Chapter 362, Transportation Code, is amended by

6 adding Subchapter Z to read as follows:

SUBCHAPTER Z. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

- 8 Sec. 362.901. FREE USE OF TOLL PROJECT BY MILITARY
- 9 VEHICLES. (a) The commission and the governing body of each local
- 10 governmental entity or private entity that operates a toll project
- 11 shall adopt rules to allow a military vehicle to use toll projects
- 12 without payment of a toll or fare.
- 13 (b) A rule adopted under this section must:
- 14 (1) allow a convoy of military vehicles of this state,
- another state, or the United States to use the toll project without
- 16 payment of a toll or fare; and
- 17 (2) allow individual military vehicles to use the toll
- 18 project without payment of a toll or fare, to the greatest extent
- 19 practicable, considering the technological and personnel
- 20 <u>limitations of operating the toll project.</u>
- 21 (c) A person who claims a privilege under a rule adopted
- 22 under this section to which the person is not entitled commits an
- 23 offense. An offense under this subsection is a Class C misdemeanor.
- 24 (d) In this section, "toll project" includes a toll road,

- 1 toll highway, turnpike, toll bridge, ferry, or similar project,
- 2 users of which are required to pay a toll or fare.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 431.087, Government Code, is repealed.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
