1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to certain records kept by persons who weigh cargo  
1-11 transported by commercial motor vehicles.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 621.410(e), Transportation Code, is  
1-14 amended to read as follows:

1-15 (e) This section does not apply to a vehicle that:

1-16 (1) transports material regulated under Section  
1-17 623.161;

1-18 (2) is weighed by a weight enforcement officer;

1-19 (3) is weighed on scales owned by the state or a  
1-20 political subdivision of the state; or

1-21 (4) is weighed on scales owned by an enterprise  
1-22 principally engaged in the retail sale of motor fuels to the general  
1-23 public.

1-24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-28 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
