- 2 relating to the review of the reimbursement methodology for and
- 3 resource needs of nursing facilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. REVIEW OF TILE CLASSIFICATION
- 6 SYSTEM. (a) Subject to the availability of funds, the Health and
- 7 Human Services Commission, in conjunction with the Texas Department
- 8 of Human Services, shall evaluate the Texas Index for Level of
- 9 Effort classification system used to quantify the intensity of the
- 10 care needs of individuals in nursing facilities and to assign daily
- 11 reimbursement rates for that care to determine whether the system
- 12 accurately accounts for the care needs of patients with dementia,
- including patients with Alzheimer's disease.
- 14 (b) In conducting the evaluation of the Texas Index for
- 15 Level of Effort classification system, the Health and Human
- 16 Services Commission shall seek the input of relevant professionals
- 17 and other individuals or organizations with expertise in caring for
- 18 people with dementia, including Alzheimer's disease.
- 19 SECTION 2. REPORT TO LEGISLATURE. The Health and Human
- 20 Services Commission shall report the results of the evaluation
- 21 conducted under this Act to the governor, the lieutenant governor,
- 22 and the speaker of the house of representatives not later than
- 23 September 1, 2004.
- 24 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September
