- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 37.007, Education Code, is amended by adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:
- 6 (i) If a school district determines that a student's conduct
- 7 cited as grounds for expulsion under this section is possibly
- 8 related to a disability of the student, the district may not expel
- 9 the student unless the district assesses the student to determine
- 10 whether:
- 11 (1) the student has a disability that requires special
- 12 <u>education services; and</u>
- 13 (2) the disability contributed to the student's
- 14 conduct.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004
- 16 school year.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
