## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to an exemption from tuition and fees at public 3 institutions of higher education for certain adopted students. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 54, Education Code, is 5 6 amended by adding Section 54.2111 to read as follows: Sec. 54.2111. EXEMPTIONS FOR ADOPTED STUDENTS FORMERLY IN 7 FOSTER OR OTHER RESIDENTIAL CARE. A student is exempt from the 8 payment of tuition and fees authorized by this chapter if the 9 student was: 10 11 (1) adopted; and 12 (2) the subject of an adoption assistance agreement 13 under Subchapter D, Chapter 162, Family Code. SECTION 2. Section 54.2111, Education Code, as added by 14 this Act, applies beginning with tuition and fees charged for the 15 2003 fall semester. Tuition and fees charged for a semester or 16 session before the 2003 fall semester are governed by the 17 applicable law in effect before the effective date of this Act, and 18 that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 20 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003. 24
