- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 33.031, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 33.031. [NO AWARD OF] COSTS, FEES, AND EXPENSES. (a)
- 9 Except as provided by Subsection (b), court [Court] costs or
- 10 attorney's fees may not be awarded in a proceeding under this
- 11 chapter.
- 12 (b) On a finding of misconduct of a judge in formal
- 13 proceedings before a special master or the commission, the
- 14 commission is entitled to recover from the judge court costs,
- 15 attorney's fees, and reasonable expenses related to the
- 16 proceedings.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to formal proceedings instituted on or after the effective date of
- 19 this Act. Formal proceedings instituted before the effective date
- 20 of this Act are governed by the law in effect at the time the
- 21 proceedings were instituted, and the former law is continued in
- 22 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
