An election on the new date may not be held before the uniform election date in May 2004 [2000].

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-17 1-18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-19 1-20 1-21 1-22 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
