## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the establishment of a geriatric education and care
3	research center for the Texas-Louisiana border region.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 74, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 74.604 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 74.604. EAST TEXAS CENTER FOR BORDER REGION GERIATRIC
8	STUDIES. (a) In this section:
9	(1) "Board" means the board of regents of The
10	University of Texas System.
11	(2) "Center" means the East Texas Center for Border
12	Region Geriatric Studies.
13	(3) "Texas-Louisiana border region" has the meaning
14	assigned by Section 2056.002, Government Code.
15	(b) The board may establish the East Texas Center for Border
16	Region Geriatric Studies at The University of Texas Health Science
17	Center at Tyler for purposes of:
18	(1) researching issues in the Texas-Louisiana border
19	region that are related to geriatrics, gerontology, and long-term
20	care for the elderly; and

region for training and research for:

pharmacy, and allied health;

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(2) providing resources in the Texas-Louisiana border

(A) professionals in medicine, nursing,

Τ	(b) caregivers and advocates for the elderly; and
2	(C) individuals employed by agencies that adopt
3	rules affecting the elderly.
4	(c) The organization, control, and management of the center
5	are vested in the board.
6	(d) If the board establishes the center, the board:
7	(1) shall provide for the employment of staff and ar
8	operating budget for the center;
9	(2) shall select a site in the Texas-Louisiana border
LO	region for the center; and
L1	(3) may solicit, accept, and administer gifts and
L2	grants from any public or private source for the use and benefit of
L3	the center.
L4	(e) Establishment of the center is subject to the
L5	availability of federal funding or other funding for that purpose.
L6	The board may not use legislative appropriations, other than
L7	federal funds or gifts or grants subject to appropriation, to
L8	establish or operate the center.
L9	(f) An employee of the center is an employee of The
20	University of Texas System.
21	(g) The center may enter into an agreement or may cooperate
22	with a public or private entity to perform the functions of the
23	center.
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
25	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
26	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
