## 1 AN ACT 2 relating to student fees at institutions in the Texas State 3 University System. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 54.5089(a), Education Code, is amended 5 6 to read as follows: (a) The board of regents of the Texas State University 7 System may charge each student registered at a component 8 institution of the Texas State University System a medical services 9 fee not to exceed \$100 [ $\frac{$55}{$55}$ ] for each semester of the regular term 10 11 or [12-week] summer session of 12 weeks or longer and not to exceed 12 <u>\$50</u> [<del>\$25</del>] for each [six-week or shorter term of the</del>] summer session of less than 12 weeks. 13 14 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 54.511, Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 15 Sec. 54.511. STUDENT FEES FOR BUS SERVICE; TEXAS STATE 16 UNIVERSITY SYSTEM [SOUTHWEST TEXAS STATE UNIVERSITY] 17 SECTION 3. Section 54.511(b), Education Code, is amended to 18 read as follows: 19 (b) Not more than once in an academic year, the board may 20 21 increase the fee authorized in Subsection (a) of this section for 22 the purpose of covering increased operating costs of the bus 23 service. Any increase in the fee must be approved by a majority 24 vote of those students participating in a general election called

for that purpose. However, the total fee may not exceed \$100 [\$46]
per semester or \$50 [\$23] per [six=week] summer term of six weeks or
less.

4 SECTION 4. Section 54.523(a), Education Code, is amended to 5 read as follows:

6 (a) To the extent approved by the students under Subsection 7 (b) of this section, the board of regents of the Texas State 8 University System may charge each student enrolled in a university or educational center under its authority a student center fee not 9 to exceed <u>\$100</u> [<del>\$70</del>] per semester or <u>\$50</u> [<del>\$35</del>] per [<del>six-week</del>] summer 10 of six weeks or less to be used to construct, operate, 11 term maintain, improve, and program a student center at the university 12 or educational center at which the student is enrolled. 13

SECTION 5. Section 54.538(a), Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) If approved by student vote at a system institution, the 16 17 Board of Regents, Texas State University System, may charge each student enrolled at such institution a recreational sports fee not 18 to exceed \$100 [<del>\$50</del>] per semester or [<del>10-week</del>] summer session of 10 19 weeks or longer or \$50 [\$25] per [five-week] summer session of less 20 21 than 10 weeks. The fee may be used to purchase equipment for and to construct, operate, and maintain recreational sports facilities 22 and programs at the designated institution. 23

24 SECTION 6. This Act applies beginning with the 2003 fall 25 semester.

26 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
