4 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 83, Parks and Wildlife

5 Code, is amended by adding Section 83.021 to read as follows:

6 Sec. 83.021. FEDERAL APPROVAL OF LAND ACQUISITIONS. (a)

7 This section applies to a conservation agreement, as defined by

Section 83.005, a habitat conservation plan, or a regional habitat

- 10 (1) received a federal permit before September 1,
- 11 1999;

- 12 (2) has planned the acquisition of more than 1,000
- 13 acres of land under the permit; and
- 14 (3) has not completed the planned acquisitions by
- 15 September 1, 2003.
- 16 (b) Not later than December 1, 2003, a permit holder shall
- 17 prepare an amendment to a plan or agreement to which this section
- 18 applies to include all land and conservation easements acquired
- 19 before December 1, 2003, by the permit holder with public money for
- 20 any environmentally related purpose and after the submission of the
- 21 original plan to the federal government. The permit holder shall
- 22 submit the amendment to the plan or agreement to the appropriate

- 3 <u>(c) The permit holder shall prepare and file an additional</u>
- 4 amendment for every 1,000 acres of land or conservation easements
- 5 <u>acquired on or after December 1, 2003, not later than 60 days after</u>
- 6 the date of the last acquisition.
- 7 (d) If the federal agency approves the use of all or part of
- 8 the land included under Subsection (b) for partial completion of
- 9 the planned acquisitions under the original plan or agreement, the
- 10 permit holder shall reduce appropriately the number of acres that
- 11 need to be acquired to complete land acquisitions under the
- 12 original plan or agreement.
- 13 (e) This section expires on September 1, 2005.
