## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to federal approval of land for habitat conservation.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 83, Parks and Wildlife
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 83.021 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 83.021. FEDERAL APPROVAL OF LAND ACQUISITIONS. (a)
7	This section applies to a conservation agreement, as defined by
8	Section 83.005, a habitat conservation plan, or a regional habitat
9	conservation plan that:
10	(1) received a federal permit before September 1,
11	<u>1999;</u>
12	(2) has planned the acquisition of more than 1,000
13	acres of land under the permit; and
14	(3) has not completed the planned acquisitions by
15	September 1, 2003.
16	(b) Permit holders shall amend a plan or agreement to which
17	this section applies to include land or conservation easements
18	acquired by the permit holders with public money for any other
19	environmentally related purpose after the submission of the
20	original plan to the federal government. The permit holders shall
21	submit the amended plan or agreement to the appropriate federal
22	agency under the federal act, for the federal agency to determine if
23	any of the land acquired can be counted toward the land planned for
24	acquisition under the original habitat preservation plan or

- 1 <u>agreement</u>.
- 2 (c) If the federal agency approves the use of all or part of
- 3 the land included under Subsection (b) for partial completion of
- 4 the planned acquisitions under the original plan or agreement, the
- 5 permit holders shall reduce appropriately the number of acres that
- 6 need to be acquired to complete land acquisitions under the
- 7 original plan or agreement.
- 8 <u>(d) This section expires on September 1, 2005.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. (a) A permit holder to whom Section 83.021, Parks
- 10 and Wildlife Code, as added by this Act, applies shall file an
- 11 amended permit with the federal government not later than December
- 12 1, 2003.
- 13 (b) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
