- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 22, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 22.007 to read as follows:
- Sec. 22.007. CLASSROOM SUPPLY REIMBURSEMENT. (a) From

 funds appropriated for this purpose, the commissioner shall

 establish a program under which each classroom teacher that expends

 personal funds for classroom supplies shall be reimbursed from
- state funds provided to school districts in the form of matching funds.

- (b) Funds provided under the program shall be used solely
- 14 for the benefit of students and the use of funds shall be at the
- 15 discretion of the classroom teacher. The commissioner shall
- 16 establish rules for the allocation of funds within a school

- 18 replace local funds being used for the same purpose.
- 19 (c) The commissioner shall identify state and federal funds

- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
