A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the expiration and appearance of a driver's license,
3	identification certificate, or commercial driver's license or
4	permit issued to a person who is not a citizen of the United States.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 521.101, Transportation Code, is amended

- 5 by amending Subsection (f) and adding Subsection (j) to read as 5 follows:
- 9 (f) A certificate expires on a date specified by the 10 department, except that:
- 11 (1) a certificate issued to a person 60 years of age or
 12 older, other than a person described by Subdivision (2), does not
 13 expire; and
- (2) a certificate issued to a person who is not a citizen of the United States expires on a date corresponding to the end of the period of legal stay as indicated by documentation issued by the federal agency responsible for citizenship and immigration.
- (j) The department shall indicate "NONCITIZEN" on the face
 of a personal identification certificate issued to a person who is
 not a citizen of the United States.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 521, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 521.127 to read as follows:
- Sec. 521.127. DESIGNATOR ON LICENSE ISSUED TO A NONCITIZEN.
 The department shall indicate "NONCITIZEN" on the face of a license

- 1 held by a person who is not a citizen of the United States.
- 2 SECTION 3. Section 521.142, Transportation Code, is amended
- 3 by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 4 (h) An applicant who is not a citizen of the United States
- 5 must present to the department documentation issued by the federal
- 6 agency responsible for citizenship and immigration authorizing the
- 7 applicant to be in the United States.
- 8 SECTION 4. Section 521.1425(b), Transportation Code, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 (b) The department shall require each applicant for an
- 11 original, renewal, or duplicate driver's license to furnish to the
- department the information required by Sections 521.142(c)(7) and
- 13 (8) and (h).
- 14 SECTION 5. Section 521.271(a), Transportation Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (a) Except as provided by Section 521.2715, each [Each]
- 17 original driver's license and provisional license expires as
- 18 follows:
- 19 (1) a driver's license expires on the first birthday of
- 20 the license holder occurring after the sixth anniversary of the
- 21 date of the application;
- 22 (2) a provisional license expires on the earlier of:
- 23 (A) the 18th birthday of the license holder; or
- 24 (B) the first birthday of the license holder
- occurring after the date of the application;
- 26 (3) an instruction permit expires on the first
- 27 birthday of the license holder occurring after the date of the

- 2 (4) an occupational license expires on the first
- 3 anniversary of the court order granting the license.
- 4 SECTION 6. Subchapter M, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- is amended by adding Section 521.2715 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 521.2715. LICENSE EXPIRATION: NONCITIZENS. A
- 7 driver's license held by a person who is not a citizen of the United
- 8 States, including a renewal, duplicate, or corrected license,
- 9 expires on the earlier of:
- 10 (1) the date specified in Section 521.271; or
- 11 (2) the date corresponding to the end of the period of
- 12 legal stay as indicated by documentation issued by the federal
- 13 agency responsible for citizenship and immigration.
- SECTION 7. Section 521.421, Transportation Code, is amended
- 15 by adding Subsection (k) to read as follows:
- 16 (k) If a driver's license issued to a person who is not a
- 17 citizen of the United States expires before the date specified in
- 18 Section 521.271, the department shall prorate the fee according to
- 19 the number of years the license is to be in effect.
- SECTION 8. Section 521.422(a), Transportation Code, is
- 21 amended to read as follows:
- 22 (a) The fee for a personal identification certificate is:
- (1) \$15 for a person under 60 years of age;
- 24 (2) \$5 for a person 60 years of age or older; [and]
- 25 (3) \$20 for a person subject to the registration
- 26 requirements under Chapter 62, Code of Criminal Procedure; and
- 27 <u>(4) for a certificate issued to a person under Section</u>

1 521.101(f)(2), the lesser of:

- 2 (A) \$3 for each year the certificate is valid; or
- 3 <u>(B)</u> \$15.
- 4 SECTION 9. Section 522.021, Transportation Code, is amended
- 5 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (a) An application for a commercial driver's license or
- 8 commercial driver learner's permit must include:
- 9 (1) the full name and current residence and mailing
- 10 address of the applicant;
- 11 (2) a physical description of the applicant, including
- 12 sex, height, and eye color;
- 13 (3) the applicant's date of birth;
- 14 (4) the applicant's social security number, unless the
- 15 application is for a nonresident commercial driver's license and
- 16 the applicant is a resident of a foreign jurisdiction;
- 17 (5) certifications, including those required by 49
- 18 C.F.R. Section 383.71(a); [and]
- 19 (6) a statement as to whether the applicant is a
- 20 citizen of the United States; and
- 21 $\underline{(7)}$ any other information required by the department.
- (e) An applicant who is not a citizen of the United States
- 23 must present to the department documentation issued by the federal
- 24 agency responsible for citizenship and immigration authorizing the
- applicant to be in the United States.
- SECTION 10. Section 522.029, Transportation Code, is
- 27 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (i) to

- 1 read as follows:
- 2 (a) The fee for a commercial driver's license or commercial
- 3 driver learner's permit issued by the department is \$60, except as
- 4 provided by Subsections (f), (h), and (i) [(h)].
- 5 (i) If a commercial driver's license or commercial driver
- 6 learner's permit issued to a person who is not a citizen of the
- 7 United States expires before the date specified in Section 522.051,
- 8 the department shall prorate the fee according to the number of
- 9 years the license or permit is to be in effect.
- 10 SECTION 11. Section 522.030, Transportation Code, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 522.030. CONTENT OF LICENSE. A commercial driver's
- 13 license must:
- 14 (1) be marked "Commercial Driver License" or "CDL";
- 15 (2) be, to the extent practicable, tamper-proof; [and]
- 16 (3) include:
- 17 (A) the name and mailing address of the person to
- 18 whom it is issued;
- 19 (B) the person's color photograph;
- 20 (C) a physical description of the person,
- 21 including sex, height, and eye color;
- 22 (D) the person's date of birth;
- (E) a number or identifier the department
- 24 considers appropriate;
- 25 (F) the person's signature;
- 26 (G) each class of commercial motor vehicle that
- 27 the person is authorized to drive, with any endorsements or

- 1 restrictions;
- 2 (H) the name of this state; and
- 3 (I) the dates between which the license is valid;
- 4 and
- 5 (4) if the person is not a citizen of the United
- 6 States, be marked "NONCITIZEN" on the face of the license.
- 7 SECTION 12. Section 522.051(a), Transportation Code, is
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 (a) Except as provided by Sections [Section] 522.033 and
- 10 <u>522.0515</u>, an original commercial driver's license or commercial
- 11 driver learner's permit expires six years after the applicant's
- 12 next birthday.
- SECTION 13. Subchapter E, Chapter 522, Transportation Code,
- is amended by adding Section 522.0515 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 522.0515. EXPIRATION OF LICENSE OR PERMIT:
- 16 NONCITIZENS. A commercial driver's license or commercial driver
- 17 learner's permit held by a person who is not a citizen of the United
- 18 States, including a renewal, duplicate, or corrected license,
- 19 expires on the earlier of:
- 20 (1) the date specified in Section 522.051 or 522.052;
- 21 <u>or</u>
- 22 (2) the date corresponding to the end of the period of
- 23 legal stay as indicated by documentation issued by the federal
- 24 agency responsible for citizenship and immigration.
- 25 SECTION 14. Section 522.052, Transportation Code, is
- amended by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 27 (h) The department shall require each applicant to furnish

- 1 to the department the information required by Sections
- 2 <u>522.021(a)(6)</u> and (e) for a:
- 3 (1) renewal, duplicate, or corrected commercial
- 4 driver's license; or
- 5 (2) duplicate or corrected commercial driver learner's
- 6 permit.
- 7 SECTION 15. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 8 to an original or renewal application for a driver's license,
- 9 personal identification certificate, commercial driver's license,
- 10 or commercial driver learner's permit submitted on or after the
- 11 effective date of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 16. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
