5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 25, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 25.0341 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 25.0341. TRANSFER OF VICTIMS OR SIBLINGS. (a) This
8	section applies only to:
9	(1) a student who is the victim of conduct described by
10	Section 37.006(a)(2)(B) or 37.007(a)(2)(A):
11	(A) committed by another student who, at the time
12	the conduct occurred, was assigned to the same campus as the victim;
13	and
14	(B) for which the student committing the conduct
15	has been placed in an alternative education program under Section
16	37.008 or expelled under Section 37.007; or
17	(2) a sibling of a student described by Subdivision
18	(1) who:
19	(A) is assigned to the same campus as the student
20	described by Subdivision (1); and
21	(B) has received a threat in connection with the
22	conduct.
23	(b) On the request of a parent or other person with
24	authority to act on behalf of a student who is a victim or a victim's

- 1 sibling to whom this section applies, the board of trustees of the
- 2 school district shall transfer the victim or sibling to a district
- 3 campus other than:
- 4 (1) the campus to which the victim or sibling was
- 5 assigned at the time the conduct occurred; or
- 6 (2) the campus to which the student who committed the
- 7 conduct is assigned, if that student has been assigned to a
- 8 different campus since the conduct occurred.
- 9 (c) A transfer under this section must be to a campus

- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
