8	right-of-way of a public road unless the placement is authorized by
9	state law.
10	(b) An individual, partnership, corporation, or other legal
11	entity that compensates a person, including an employee, for
12	placing a commercial sign on the right-of-way of a public road in
13	violation of this section is considered to have placed the sign in
14	violation of this section and may be prosecuted under Section
15	393.005.
16	(c) An individual, partnership, corporation, or other legal
17	entity that is advertised on a commercial sign placed on the
18	right-of-way of a public road in violation of this section is
19	considered to have placed the sign in violation of this section and
20	may be prosecuted under Section 393.005.
21	SECTION 2. Section 393.0025, Transportation Code, is
22	amended by adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
23	(c) An individual, partnership, corporation, or other legal

5	(d) An individual, partnership, corporation, or other legal
6	entity that is advertised on a commercial sign placed on the
7	right-of-way of a road or highway maintained by a municipality in
8	violation of this section is considered to have placed the sign in
9	violation of this section and may be prosecuted under Section
10	<u>393.005.</u>
11	SECTION 3. Section 393.005(a), Transportation Code, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	(a) A person commits an offense if the person <u>violates</u>
14	[places a sign in violation of] Section 393.002 <u>or 393.0025</u> .
15	SECTION 4. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
16	only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
17	Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
18	the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
19	before that date.
20	(b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
21	Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
22	and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
23	SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
