- 8 violation of this section is considered to have placed the sign in
- 9 violation of this section and may be prosecuted under Section
- 10 393.005.
- 11 SECTION 3. Section 393.005(a), Transportation Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) A person commits an offense if the person $\underline{\text{violates}}$
- 14 [places a sign in violation of] Section 393.002 or 393.0025.
- 15 SECTION 4. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 17 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
- 18 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
- 19 before that date.
- 20 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 21 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
