5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 15.903, Water Code, as added by Chapter
7	966, Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is
8	amended to read as follows:
9	Sec. 15.903. WATER INFRASTRUCTURE FUND. (a) The water
10	infrastructure fund is a special <u>fund</u> [account] in the <u>state</u>
11	treasury [general revenue fund] to be administered by the board
12	under this subchapter and rules adopted by the board under this
13	subchapter. Money in the fund may be used to pay for the
14	implementation of water projects recommended through the state and
15	regional water planning processes under Sections 16.051 and 16.053.
16	(b) The fund consists of:
17	(1) appropriations from the legislature;
18	(2) any other fees or sources of revenue that the
19	legislature may dedicate for deposit to the fund;

- 10 Session, 2001, is amended to read as follows:
- 11 (e) A loan provided under this subchapter may not exceed <u>a</u>
- 12 [\$250,000 for each project, and the] term of [a loan may not exceed]
- 13 20 years.
- SECTION 3. Section 15.951, Water Code, as added by Chapter
- 15 966, Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 15.951. PURPOSE. The legislature finds that the rural
- 18 areas of the state, characterized by small populations extended
- 19 over disproportionately large service areas, require a means of
- 20 financing water and water quality enhancement projects in addition
- 21 to those established by other provisions of this chapter.
- SECTION 4. Section 15.953, Water Code, as added by Chapter
- 23 966, Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is
- 24 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 15.953. FUND. The rural water assistance fund is a
- 26 special fund [account] in the state treasury [general revenue
- 27 **fund**]. The fund consists of:

- 1 (1) money directly appropriated to the board;
- 2 (2) repayment of principal and interest from loans
- 3 made from the fund not otherwise needed as a source of revenue
- 4 pursuant to Section 17.9615(b);
- 5 (3) money transferred by the board from any sources
- 6 available; and
- 7 (4) interest earned on the investment of money in the
- 8 fund and depository interest allocable to the fund [in the general
- 9 revenue fund].
- SECTION 5. Subsections (a) and (b), Section 15.954, Water
- 11 Code, as added by Chapter 966, Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular
- 12 Session, 2001, are amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) The fund may be used to provide low-interest loans to
- 14 rural political subdivisions for water or water-related projects
- and for water quality enhancement projects, including the purchase
- 16 of well fields, the purchase or lease of rights to produce
- 17 groundwater, onsite or wetland wastewater treatment facilities,
- 18 and interim financing of construction projects.
- 19 (b) The fund may be used to enable a rural political
- 20 subdivision to obtain water or wastewater service supplied by
- 21 larger political subdivisions or to finance the consolidation or
- 22 regionalizing of neighboring political subdivisions, or both.
- SECTION 6. Subsections (a) and (b), Section 15.952, Water
- 24 Code, as added by Chapter 1234, Acts of the 77th Legislature,
- 25 Regular Session, 2001, are amended to read as follows:
- 26 (a) The colonia self-help account is an account in the water
- 27 assistance fund [general revenue fund] that may be used by the board

- 1 [appropriated] only for the purposes of this subchapter.
- 2 (b) The account consists of:
- 3 (1) money transferred by the legislature directly to
- 4 the account;
- 5 (2) money transferred at the board's discretion from
- 6 the fund; and
- 7 (3) gifts, grants, or donations to the account[; and
- 8 [(4) interest earned on money credited to the
- 9 account].
- 10 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
