

AN ACT

relating to certain filing fees in a suit affecting the parent-child relationship.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 110.002(a), Family Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The clerk of the court may collect a filing fee of \$15 in a suit for filing:

- (1) a suit or motion for modification;
- (2) a motion for enforcement;
- (3) a notice of application for judicial writ of withholding;
- (4) a motion to transfer; ~~[-]~~
- (5) a petition for license suspension; ~~[or]~~
- (6) a motion to revoke a stay of license suspension; or
- (7) a motion for contempt.

SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

(b) The change in law made by this Act applies only to a suit affecting the parent-child relationship or motion in a suit affecting the parent-child relationship filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A suit affecting the parent-child relationship or motion in a suit affecting the parent-child relationship filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the suit or motion was

1 filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
