A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to certain filing fees in a suit affecting the
3 parent-child relationship.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 110.002(a), Family Code, is amended to
6 read as follows:

7 (a) The clerk of the court may collect a filing fee of \$15 in
8 a suit for filing:

9 (1) a suit or motion for modification;

10 (2) a motion for enforcement;

11 (3) a notice of application for judicial writ of
12 withholding;

13 (4) a motion to transfer.

14 (5) a petition for license suspension; [~~or~~]

15 (6) a motion to revoke a stay of license suspension; or

16 (7) a motion for contempt.

17 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

18 (b) The change in law made by this Act applies only to a suit
19 affecting the parent-child relationship or motion in a suit
20 affecting the parent-child relationship filed on or after the
21 effective date of this Act. A suit affecting the parent-child
22 relationship or motion in a suit affecting the parent-child
23 relationship filed before the effective date of this Act is
24 governed by the law in effect on the date the suit or motion was

1 filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
