A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the exemption from ad valorem taxation of property
- 3 owned by a religious organization.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.43, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (1) to read as follows:
- 7 (1) This subsection applies only to a religious
- 8 organization that has conscientious objections to filing an
- 9 application for exemption under Section 11.20. In lieu of filing an
- 10 application for the exemption, the religious organization at any
- 11 time during the tax year, on its own initiative or on written or
- oral inquiry by the appraisal office, may identify the property
- 13 owned by the organization, state its objections to filing an
- 14 application for the exemption, and submit evidence showing that it
- 15 <u>is not subject to taxation. On receipt of the information submitted</u>
- 16 by the religious organization, the chief appraiser shall
- 17 <u>investigate</u> whether the information is correct. Unless the chief
- 18 appraiser determines that the information is not correct, the
- 19 property is not subject to taxation.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
