5	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 502.2736 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 502.2736. SMILE TEXAS STYLE LICENSE PLATES. (a) The
8	department shall issue specially designed "Smile Texas Style"
9	license plates for passenger cars and light trucks.

- 10 (b) The license plates must include the words "Smile Texas

 11 Style" and be designed by the department in consultation with the

 12 Texas Dental Association.
- 13 <u>(c) The department shall issue license plates under this</u> 14 section to a person who:
- (1) applies to the county assessor-collector of the county in which the person resides on a form provided by the department; and
- 18 (2) pays an annual fee of \$30, in addition to the fee 19 prescribed by Section 502.161 and, if personalized prestige license 20 plates are issued, in addition to the fee prescribed by Section 21 502.251.
- 22 <u>(d) Of each fee collected under this section:</u>
- 23 (1) \$22 shall be deposited to the credit of the general 24 revenue fund to be used only by the Texas Department of Health in

- 1 making grants to benefit the Texas Dental Association Financial
- 2 Services for the sole use of providing charitable dental care; and
- 3 (2) \$8 shall be deposited to the credit of the state
- 4 highway fund to defray the cost of administering this section.
- 5 (e) If license plates issued under this section are lost,
- 6 stolen, or mutilated, the owner of the vehicle for which the license
- 7 plates were issued may obtain replacement plates from the
- 8 department by paying a replacement fee of \$5. If the owner of a
- 9 vehicle registered under this section disposes of the vehicle
- 10 during the registration year, the owner shall return the special
- 11 license plates to the department.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
