A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to increasing the civil and criminal penalties for certain 3 violations committed by a towing company or a parking facility 4 owner.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 684.084(c), Transportation Code, is 7 amended to read as follows:

8 (c) A towing company or parking facility owner who 9 intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly violates this chapter is 10 liable to the owner or operator of the vehicle that is the subject 11 of the violation for <u>\$500</u> [\$300] plus three times the amount of fees 12 assessed in the vehicle's removal, towing, or storage.

SECTION 2. Section 684.085, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 684.085. VIOLATION OF CHAPTER; FINE. A violation of this chapter is punishable by a fine of not less than <u>\$500</u> [\$200] or more than <u>\$1,000</u> [\$500].

SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to a violation that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. A violation that occurs before the effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the violation occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, a violation occurred before the effective date of this Act if any element of the violation occurred before that date.
