18	official title of the early voting clerk as addressee, [ <del>and</del> ] the
19	clerk's official mailing address, and, if different than the
20	official mailing address, the clerk's physical address must be
21	printed on the face of each official carrier envelope for a ballot
22	to be voted by mail.
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
24	applies only to early voting by mail for an election ordered on or
