## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

relating to the price of export stamps issued by the comptroller of public accounts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Section $151.158(g)$, Tax Code, is amended to read as follows:
(g) The comptroller shall charge $\$ 1$ [an amount not toexceed five cents] for each stamp. [The comptrollex shall use the money from the sale of the stampsonly for costsrelated to producing the stamps, including costs of matexials, labor, and overhead.]

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and applies only to export stamps sold on or after that date. An export stamp sold before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the stamp was sold, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
