A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the issuance of share the road license plates.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
5	is amended by adding Section 502.2737 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 502.2737. SHARE THE ROAD LICENSE PLATES. (a) The
7	department shall issue specially designed license plates for
8	passenger cars and light trucks that include:
9	(1) the words "Share The Road"; and
10	(2) an image of a bicycle or a bicycle with a rider.
11	(b) The department shall design the license plates in
12	consultation with the Texas Bicycle Coalition Education Fund.
13	(c) The department shall issue license plates under this
14	section to a person who:
15	(1) applies to the assessor-collector of the county in
16	which the person resides on a form provided by the department; and
17	(2) pays an annual fee of \$35, in addition to the fee
18	prescribed by Section 502.161 or 502.162, and if personalized
19	prestige license plates are issued, in addition to the fee
20	prescribed by Section 502.251.
21	(d) Of each fee collected under Subsection (c)(2):
22	(1) \$8 shall be deposited to the credit of the state
23	highway fund to be used by the department only to defray the cost of
24	administering:

1	(A) this section; and
2	(B) any bicycle-related programs of the
3	department;
4	(2) \$5 shall be deposited to the credit of an account
5	in the general revenue fund that may be appropriated only to the
6	Texas Education Agency to promote motorist awareness of bicyclists
7	in driver and traffic safety education; and
8	(3) \$22 shall be deposited to the credit of the share
9	the road account in the state treasury to be used by the Texas
10	Education Agency to support the activities of a nonprofit
11	organization whose primary purpose is to promote bicyclist safety,
12	education, and access through:
13	(A) education and awareness programs; and
14	(B) training, workshops, educational materials,
15	and media events.
16	(e) Up to 25 percent of the amount in Subsection (d)(3) may
17	be used to support the activities of the nonprofit organization in
18	marketing and promoting the share the road concept and license
19	plates.
20	(f) The Texas Education Agency may establish reporting and
21	other mechanisms necessary to ensure that the money collected under
22	this section is spent for purposes for which it is dedicated.
23	(g) If license plates issued under this section are lost,
24	stolen, or mutilated, the owner of the vehicle for which the license
25	plates were issued may obtain replacement license plates from the
26	department by paying a replacement fee of \$5.
27	(h) If the owner of a vehicle registered under this section

- 1 disposes of the vehicle during the registration year, the owner
- 2 shall return the special license plates to the department.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
