- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 5.11, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 5.11. <u>EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR</u> [<u>ADMINISTRATOR</u>]. <u>(a)</u> The
- 9 commission shall appoint an $\underline{\text{executive director}}$ [$\underline{\text{administrator}}$] to
- 10 serve at its will and, subject to its supervision, administer this
- 11 code. Unless the commission orders otherwise, the $\underline{\text{executive}}$
- 12 director [administrator] shall be manager, secretary, and
- 13 custodian of all records. The executive director [administrator]
- 14 shall devote the executive director's [his] entire time to the
- 15 office and shall receive a salary as appropriated by the
- 16 legislature. The <u>executive director</u> [administrator] shall execute
- a bond in the sum of \$10,000, payable to the state, and conditioned
- 18 as the commission requires.
- 19 (b) A reference in this code or another law to the
- 20 <u>administrator of the commission means the executive director.</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 5.13, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 5.13. DEPUTY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR [ASSISTANT
- 24 ADMINISTRATOR]. The executive director [administrator] shall

- appoint a deputy executive director [an assistant administrator]. 1 2 The <u>deputy executive director</u> [assistant administrator] must meet the same qualifications as the <u>executive director</u> [administrator]. 3 The <u>deputy executive director</u> [assisant administrator] shall take 4 the constitutional oath of office and make a bond in the same amount 5 6 on the same conditions as the <u>executive director's</u> [administrator's] bond. In the absence of the executive director 7 [administrator], or in case of the executive director's [his] 8 9 inability to act, the deputy executive director [assistant administrator] shall perform the duties conferred on the executive 10 <u>director</u> [administrator] by law or delegated to the <u>executive</u> 11 director [administrator] by the commission. If there is a vacancy 12 in the office of $\underline{\text{executive director}}$ [$\underline{\text{administrator}}$], the $\underline{\text{deputy}}$ 13 executive director [assistant administrator] shall perform the 14 15 duties of the <u>executive</u> [administrator] until an <u>executive</u> director [administrator] has been appointed by the commission. At 16 17 other times the deputy executive director [he] shall perform those duties and have those functions, powers, and authority as may be 18 delegated to the deputy executive director [him] by the executive 19 director [administrator]. 20
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
