1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to unexpended proceeds from the sale or license of
1-10 treatment programs developed by the Texas Youth Commission.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 61.054, Human Resources Code, is amended
1-13 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-14 (c) At the end of each fiscal year, any unexpended proceeds
1-15 from the sale or license of a treatment program shall be carried
1-16 over to the next fiscal year to the credit of the fund that provided
1-17 the money to finance the development of the treatment program.

1-18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-22 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
