4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 262.001, Family Code is amended to read
6	as follows:
7	Sec. 262.001. AUTHORIZED ACTIONS BY GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY.
8	(a) A governmental entity with an interest in the child may file a
9	suit affecting the parent-child relationship requesting an order or
10	take possession of a child without a court order as provided by this
11	chapter.
12	(b) In determining the reasonable efforts that are required
13	to be made with respect to preventing or eliminating the need to
14	remove a child from the child's home or to make it possible to
15	return a child to the child's home, the child's health and safety is
16	the paramount concern.
17	(c) Civilian employees or volunteers of law enforcement
18	agencies may aid or assist police officers with the temporary care
19	of children until further arrangements regarding the child's
20	custody can be made.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
