A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-8 relating to a study regarding goals, outcome standards, and objectives in certain contracts with the Department of Protective 1-9 1-10 1-11 and Regulatory Services.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. STUDY. The Department of Protective and Regulatory Services shall conduct a study of a random sample of five 1-13 percent of the department's state office contracts under Chapter 40, Human Resources Code, through which program services for children are provided. The department shall determine the extent 1-14 1**-**15 1**-**16 1-17 to which each contractor under those contracts is achieving:

(1) the goals and outcomes included in the contract; 1-18 1-19 and

1-20 1-21 federally mandated and state-mandated objectives (2) of the program.

1-22 SECTION 2. REPORT. Not later than December 31, 2004, the 1-23 Department of Protective and Regulatory Services shall report to the governor, the legislature, the Legislative Budget Board, the 1-24 Sunset Advisory Commission, and the State Auditor's Office regarding the results of the study. The report must include recommendations regarding additional goals and outcome standards 1-25 1-26 1-27 designed to improve program services for children that department recommends for inclusion in future contracts. 1-28 the 1-29

1-30 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September 1-31 1, 2003.

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
