- 6 (g) In this section, "relative" means a grandparent,

- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
- 9 applies to a person receiving financial assistance under Chapter
- 10 31, Human Resources Code, on or after that date, regardless of the
- 11 date on which eligibility for that assistance was determined.
