- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 37, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 37.021 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 37.021. NOTICE OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION. (a) In this
- 8 section:
- 9 (1) "Disciplinary action" means a suspension,
- 10 expulsion, placement in an alternative education program, or other
- 11 <u>limitation in enrollment eligibility of a student by a district or</u>
- 12 school.
- 13 (2) "District or school" includes an independent
- 14 school district, a home-rule school district, a campus or campus
- program charter holder, or an open-enrollment charter school.
- 16 (b) If a district or school takes disciplinary action
- 17 against a student and the student subsequently enrolls in another
- 18 <u>district or school before the expiration of the period of</u>
- 19 <u>disciplinary action</u>, the governing body of the district or school
- 20 taking the disciplinary action shall provide to the district or
- 21 school in which the student enrolls, at the same time other records
- of the student are provided, a copy of the order of disciplinary

- (c) Subject to Section 37.007(e), the district or school in

- 1 which the student enrolls may continue the disciplinary action
- 2 under the terms of the order or may allow the student to attend
- 3 regular classes without completing the period of disciplinary
- 4 action.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 37.008(j), Education Code, is repealed.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004
- 7 school year.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
