- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 31.104, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(e) The board of trustees of a school district may not</u>
- 8 require an employee of the district to pay for a textbook or
- 9 instructional technology that is stolen, misplaced, or not returned
- 10 <u>by a student.</u>
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 31.104(e), Education Code, as added by
- this Act, applies beginning with the 2003-2004 school year.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
