- 2 relating to an exemption from The Texas Engineering Practice Act
- 3 for certain public works.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1001.053, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1001.053. PUBLIC WORKS. The following work is exempt
- 8 from this chapter:
- 9 (1) a public work that involves structural,
- 10 electrical, or mechanical engineering, if the contemplated expense
- for the completed project is $$20,000 \ [\$8,000]$ or less;
- 12 (2) a public work that does not involve structural,
- 13 electrical, or mechanical engineering, if the contemplated expense
- 14 for the completed project is \$20,000 or less; or
- 15 (3) road maintenance or improvement undertaken by the
- 16 commissioners court of a county.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect June 1, 2003, if it
- 18 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 19 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 20 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that
- 21 date, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
