8	shall make reasonable efforts to appoint a sufficient number of
9	election clerks who are fluent in both English and Spanish to serve
10	the needs of the Spanish-speaking voters of the precinct.
11	(b) If the number of election clerks appointed under
12	Subsection (a) is insufficient to serve the needs of the
13	Spanish-speaking voters in the election, the authority holding the
14	election shall appoint at least one clerk who is fluent in both
15	English and Spanish to serve at a central location to provide
16	assistance for Spanish-speaking voters. On a primary election day,
17	the county chairs of each party holding a primary shall each appoint
18	one clerk under this subsection.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
