A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to procurement rules, guidelines, and procedures for
3	regional transportation authorities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 452.106, Transportation Code, is amended 6 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as 7 follows:
- 8 (a) The executive committee may adopt and enforce 9 procurement procedures, guidelines, and rules:
- 10 (1) defining the terms in and implementing Sections 11 452.107 and 452.108(a) and (b); or
- 12 (2) covering:
- 13 (A) the appointment of contracting officers;
- 14 (B) the solicitation for and award of contracts,
- including the electronic transmission of bids and proposals and the
- 16 use of the reverse auction procedure, as defined by Section
- 17 <u>2155.062</u>, Government Code;
- 18 (C) the resolution of protests and contract
- 19 disputes;
- 20 (D) foreign currency transactions and
- 21 conversions and foreign exchange rate risk management; or
- 22 (E) other aspects of the procurement process for
- 23 domestic and international contracts.
- 24 (c) A procurement procedure, guideline, or rule covering

- 1 the electronic transmission of bids and proposals must provide:
- 2 (1) for the identification, security, and
- 3 confidentiality of an electronic bid or proposal;
- 4 (2) that an electronic bid or proposal is not required
- 5 to be sealed; and
- 6 (3) that an electronic bid or proposal remains
- 7 <u>effectively unopened until the appropriate time.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 452.107(a), Transportation Code, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), an authority may
- 11 not award a contract for construction, services, or property, other
- than real property, except through the solicitation of competitive
- 13 sealed bids or proposals, including the reverse auction procedure,
- 14 ensuring full and open competition.
- 15 SECTION 3. (a) The changes in law made by this Act to a
- 16 regional transportation authority's contract rules, guidelines,
- and procedures apply only to a procurement for which the authority
- 18 first advertises or otherwise solicits bids or proposals on or
- 19 after September 1, 2003.
- 20 (b) A procurement for which the regional transportation
- 21 authority first advertised or otherwise solicited bids or proposals
- 22 before September 1, 2003, is governed by the law as it existed
- 23 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 24 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
