- (1) A court or the court's designee shall ensure that an attorney appointed under this article or under Chapter 26 to represent an indigent defendant is provided sufficient notice of the defendant's first court appearance following the attorney's appointment.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
