A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the regulation of certain operating room nurses
3	employed by certain other health providers.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 301, Occupations Code, is
6	amended by adding Sections 301.1526 and 301.1527 to read as
7	follows:
8	Sec. 301.1526. CERTAIN NURSES DIRECTLY ASSISTING IN
9	SURGERY. (a) This section does not apply to a registered nurse who

- is a nurse first assistant under Section 301.1525.

 (b) A registered nurse to whom this section applies may
- 12 directly assist a physician, physician's group, podiatrist, or
- dentist to perform surgery if the nurse:
- 14 (1) has, before September 1, 2003, directly assisted
- the physician, physician's group, podiatrist, or dentist to perform
- 16 surgery for 2,500 or more hours;
- 17 (2) assists under the direct personal supervision and
- 18 in the physical presence of the physician, physician's group,
- 19 podiatrist, or dentist in the same sterile field; and
- 20 (3) is employed by the physician, physician's group,
- 21 podiatrist, or dentist or by a hospital licensed under Chapter 241,
- 22 Health and Safety Code.
- 23 (c) In this section, "directly assisting in surgery":
- 24 <u>(1) includes:</u>

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1	(A) holding a retractor;
2	(B) grasping tissue;
3	(C) using a suction device;
4	(D) sponging a wound; and
5	(E) following a suture while the physician,
6	physician's group, podiatrist, or dentist sews tissue; and
7	(2) does not include:
8	(A) making an incision;
9	(B) inserting a laparoscopic trocar;
10	(C) tying a suture; or
11	(D) placing a suture or staple.
12	(d) A registered nurse, physician, physician's group,
13	podiatrist, or dentist, or the facility at which surgery is
14	performed under this section, may not separately bill the services
15	of the registered nurse to the patient or to any third-party
16	<u>insurer.</u>
17	(e) A registered nurse to whom this section applies may not
18	use:
19	(1) the title "nurse first assistant" or "registered
20	<pre>nurse first assistant";</pre>
21	(2) the abbreviation "R.N.F.A."; or
22	(3) any other title or abbreviation that implies to
23	the public that the person is qualified as a nurse first assistant
24	under Section 301.1525.
25	(f) This section expires January 1, 2007.
26	Sec. 301.1527. CERTAIN NURSES DIRECTLY ASSISTING IN SURGERY
27	IN SMALL HOSPITALS. (a) In this section, "small hospital" means a

1	hospital licensed under Chapter 241, Health and Safety Code, that
2	has 100 or fewer beds.
3	(b) This section does not apply to a registered nurse who is
4	a nurse first assistant under Section 301.1525.
5	(c) A registered nurse to whom this section applies may
6	directly assist a physician, physician's group, podiatrist, or
7	dentist to perform surgery at a small hospital if the nurse:
8	(1) has, before September 1, 2003, directly assisted
9	the physician, physician's group, podiatrist, or dentist to perform
LO	surgery for 2,500 or more hours;
L1	(2) assists under the direct personal supervision and
L2	in the physical presence of the physician, physician's group,
L3	podiatrist, or dentist in the same sterile field; and
L4	(3) is employed by the physician, physician's group,
L5	podiatrist, or dentist or by the small hospital.
L6	(d) In this section, "directly assisting in surgery":
L7	(1) includes:
L8	(A) holding a retractor;
L9	(B) grasping tissue;
20	(C) using a suction device;
21	(D) sponging a wound; and
22	(E) following a suture while the physician,
23	physician's group, podiatrist, or dentist sews tissue; and
24	(2) does not include:
25	(A) making an incision;
26	(B) inserting a laparoscopic trocar;

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(C) tying a suture; or

- 2 (e) A registered nurse, physician, physician's group,
- 3 podiatrist, or dentist, or the facility at which surgery is
- 4 performed under this section, may not separately bill the services
- 5 of the registered nurse to the patient or to any third-party

- 7 (f) A registered nurse to whom this section applies may not
- 8 use:
- 9 <u>(1) the title "nurse first assistant" or "registered</u>
- 10 nurse first assistant";
- 11 (2) the abbreviation "R.N.F.A."; or
- 12 <u>(3) any other title or abbreviation that implies to</u>
- 13 the public that the person is qualified as a nurse first assistant
- 14 under Section 301.1525.
- 15 SECTION 2. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 17 (b) Section 301.1527, Occupations Code, as added by this
- 18 Act, takes effect January 1, 2007.
