3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 42.001(1), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	(1) "Resident" means:
7	(A) an individual who has resided continuously in
8	this state for more than six months immediately before applying for
9	a hunting license;
10	(B) a member of the United States armed forces on
11	active duty;
12	(C) a dependent of a member of the United States
13	armed forces on active duty; [ <del>or</del> ]
14	(D) a member of any other category of individuals
15	that the commission by regulation designates as residents; or
16	(E) a member of the Kickapoo Traditional Tribe of
17	Texas.
18	SECTION 2. Chapter 42, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended
19	by adding Sections 42.015 and 42.016 to read as follows:
20	Sec. 42.015. KICKAPOO DEER HUNTING LICENSE. (a) The

- 11 a Kickapoo hunting license is \$8 or an amount set by the commission,
- whichever amount is greater, but not to exceed \$75.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
