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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 92.008, Property Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsections (h) and (i) to read as follows:
- 8 (h) Except as provided by Subsection (i), a landlord who
- 9 interrupts utility services for bona fide repairs or construction
- 10 under this section shall deliver written notice of the impending
- 11 interruption to a tenant affected by the interruption not later
- 12 than 72 hours before the time that repair or construction work
- 13 begins. The notice must specify the estimated amount of time
- 14 necessary to complete the repairs or construction.
- 15 (i) A landlord who interrupts utility services for an
- 16 emergency is not required to provide notice under Subsection (h).
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
