## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the re-enrollment of certain students who are expelled
- 3 from a public school.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 37, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 37.0071 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 37.0071. RE-ENROLLMENT OF CERTAIN EXPELLED STUDENTS.
- 8 Except as provided by Section 37.007(e), a school that expels a
- 9 student under this subchapter must allow the student to re-enroll
- 10 in the school if:
- 11 (1) the student enrolls in an open-enrollment charter
- 12 school following the expulsion; and
- 13 (2) the charter school discontinues operations for any
- 14 reason.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004
- 16 school year, and applies to any student who is expelled from a
- 17 public school under Subchapter A, Chapter 37, Education Code, as
- amended by this Act, regardless of the date the student is expelled.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
